



# ***CSC Full-Scholarship for Students in Exchange Programs***

## ***Program introduction***

China Scholarship Council (hereinafter referred to as CSC), entrusted by the Ministry of Education of China, is responsible for the enrollment and administration of Chinese Government Scholarship Programs. China Three Gorges University (CTGU), being one of the United Nations Academy Impact (UNAI) members, is one of the authorized universities to accept the CSC scholarship students. The CSC Full-Scholarship for Students in Exchange Programs is established to sponsor the American or European students recommended by CTGU partner universities to be exchanged to and study in CTGU.

## ***Duration of study: 3-6 months /10-12 months***

The scholarship will cover all the expenses as below:

1. For 3-6 months study: refund of one way international air-ticket at economy class (no more than 6,000 RMB, which is about 1,000 USD or 800 EUR);
- For 10-12 months study: refund of international air-ticket at economy class (no more than 12,000 RMB, which is about 2,000 USD or 1600 EUR);
2. Tuition fee.
3. Accommodation fee.
4. Insurance.
5. Registration fee.

- The students are expected to pay for their own living expenses (around 1000RMB/month/ person)

2. Copy of Passport (Photo Page)
3. Recommendation letter from your home university
4. Official Academic Transcript from your home university
5. Study Plan (selected courses)
6. Records of Health Examination if the study is longer than six months
