## **VISA INFORMATION**

The student visa should be obtained in student's home country.

In order to apply for the visa, the student is required to present a Letter of Acceptance issued by the University Finis Terrae at the Chilean Embassy or Consulate.

Once in Chile, the student is required to regiser the visa at *Policia de Investigaciones (PDI)* and to apply for a temporary ID Card at the *Registro Civil* (RC) within 30 days of arrival. Universidad Finis Terrae arrange a special appointment with both PDI and RC for all the exchange students.

## **EXCHANGE STUDENTS WILLING TO STAY TWO SEMESTERS AT FINIS TERRAE UNIVERSITY**

The acceptance for a second exchange semester is conditioned to:

- Have had an appropriate behavior, good grades, and minimum 70% of attendance to classes, during the first semester.
  - Applying for the second semester during the regular application period.
- Participate in the orientation period (two weeks) of the second semester to support new exchange students arrival and integration.
