ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

<p>Deadlines</p>	<p>The admission procedure for exchange students coming to Universidade Fernando Pessoa includes two mandatory steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The home university nominates the student with the following information <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Student's name</i> • <i>Study area/Course</i> • <i>Period of studies (1st/2nd semester or annual)</i> • <i>Cycle of Studies/Level</i> • <i>Student's email</i> 2. The student submits the application to Universidade Fernando Pessoa until: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • June 20 for Autumn semester (September to February) • November 18 for Spring semester (February to July) <p>The application form is available on the website: http://igateway.ufp.pt.</p> <p>All the original documents must be sent by email to gri@ufp.edu.pt and by registered mail until the due date to the following address: <i>Universidade Fernando Pessoa Gabinete de Relações Internacionais Praça 9 de Abril, 349 4249-004 Porto Portugal</i></p>
<p>Documents to submit online and send with the Application Form by post mail</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 color photographs (official passport type of photo, 3x4 cm, with bright background in jpg format - any other pictures won't be accepted; one of the pictures must be pasted in the original Application Form); • Copy of Identity Card or Passport; • Official Transcript of Records issued by the home University in English language signed and stamped; • Copy of the European Health Insurance Card or International Health Insurance Contract; • Learning Agreement (Erasmus+ student Exchange student); • Certificate/Language Proficiency Form of English or Portuguese B1 issued by the home University.

Portuguese language intensive course	During the orientation week, in the morning, there is a Portuguese language intensive course. Presence is not mandatory and it is not necessary to register.

LANGUAGES	
Portuguese for Foreigners course	<p>Portuguese for Foreigners classes are taught throughout the semester and were organized according to the EUFICCS' (European Use of Full-Immersion, Culture, Content, Service approach for Language Learning) methodology. It was named after the project funded by the European Commission, Education and Culture DG, under the Lifelong Learning Programme - Key Activity 2 (Languages), in which University Fernando Pessoa participated with 3 partners (Associazione Culturale Ulisse and Siena Italian Studies, from Italy, and Centro de Lenguas y Educaci3n Cultural, from Spain).</p> <p>Therefore, classes will be divided into 3 components:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Portuguese language (3 ECTS): teaching of the Portuguese language and grammar; 2. Contents (2 ECTS): reading and discussion of different texts to develop the capacity to reflect on the contents taught, as well as to notice characteristics of the society students are living in; 3. Reflective Writing (1 ECTS): developing an innovative reflective intercultural competence, facilitating a full involvement in the Portuguese society. <p>Students can add this course to their learning agreement and choose one or more modules. All international students can attend this course weather they add it to the learning agreement or not.</p>
